


"Beware of God, Not Satan"



Prayer: Psalms 1:1-6 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. (2) But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. (3) And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper. (4) The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away. (5) Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. (6) For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.



Proverbs 1:7 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of knowledge: [but] fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Notes:

- Fear = terror, dread, horror, fright
- Knowledge = understanding, comprehension
- Wisdom = good judgment, intelligence

Isaiah 45:4-7 For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I have even called thee by thy name: I have surnamed thee, though thou hast not known me. (5) I *am* the LORD, and *there is* none else, *there is* no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me: (6) That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else. (7) I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things.

Notes:

- God gave him power to subdue his enemies for Jacob's sake.
- I am the Lord = Jesus
- He is the only God we have ever known in our flesh and blood bodies.

Ecclesiastes 9:3 This is an evil among all things that are done under the sun, that there is one event unto all: yea, also the heart of the sons of men is full of evil, and madness is in their heart while they live, and after that they go to the dead.

Notes:

- The dead sleep in their graves until Jesus returns. Therefore they know nothing and have no portion in anything done under the SUN. When Jesus returns the SUN will be no more.



Genesis 2:7-9, 16-18 And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. (8) And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed. (9) And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. 16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: (17) But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. (18) And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him.

Notes:

- Dust + Breath = Living Soul
- Tree of Life = Jesus
- Tree of the knowledge of good & evil = Satan
- 7th day = From sundown on Friday to sundown on Saturday



Genesis 3:1-15, 19 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? (2) And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: (3) But of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. (4) And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: (5) For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. (6) And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. (7) And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. (8) And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden. (9) And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where *art* thou? (10) And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I *was* naked; and I hid myself. (11) And he said, Who told thee that thou *wast* naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? (12) And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. (13) And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat. (14) And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou art cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life: (15) And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. [19] In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.

Notes:

- Eve was deceived, not Adam.
- Satan's first lie = Ye shall not surely die
- Adam and Eve ate (listened to) the fruit of lies (from Satan), not an apple.
- The first thing that died because of sin was the animals God killed to make clothing for Adam and Eve to cover themselves.
- Eve's Seed = Jesus
- Enmity = hatred
- All men are supposed to work to take care of their families.
- Adam & Eve died physically (returned to the dust), not spiritually.
- A day to God is 1000 years. Neither Adam nor Eve lived to be 1000 years old, thus they died the same day (before the 1000 years ended).

Matthew 13:37-40 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; (38) The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked *one*; (39) The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. (40) As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.

Notes:

- Son of Man = Jesus
- His Kingdom = Jesus' kingdom on the earth, not the Father's kingdom.
- The righteous are to grow with the wicked and continue until the end. Don't let them take you away from God. Understand, there will be devils among the righteous, so don't be dismayed by it. Stay the course.

Ezekiel 28:1-3, 5, 11-16 The word of the LORD came again unto me, saying, (2) Son of man, say unto the prince of Tyrus, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thine heart is lifted up, and thou hast said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of God, in the midst of the seas; yet thou art a man, and not God, though thou set thine heart as the heart of God: (3) Behold, thou art wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from thee: [5] By thy great wisdom and by thy traffick hast thou increased thy riches, and thine heart is lifted up

because of thy riches: [11] Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, (12) Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty. (13) Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone [was] thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created. (14) Thou [art] the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee [so]: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. (15) *Thou [wast] perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created,* till iniquity was found in thee. (16) By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

Notes:

- King of Tyrus = Satan
 - He rebelled against God and wants to be a god but his end is the lake of fire.
- Cherub = Angel
- Cast = to throw down
- Ground = Earth
- Mountain of God = 3rd Heaven
- There were only 4 beings in the Garden of Eden:
 1. Tree of Life (JESUS)
 2. Tree of knowledge of good & evil (Satan)
 3. Adam
 4. Eve
- Satan can't make you do anything. He is the consequence of your bad behavior.
- God is his Master and his boss and He will send him to you if you continue to disobey. Beware of God, not Satan. God rules over all.
- The 'WAR' between good and evil is between your ears (your mind).



the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, (8) And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. (9) And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. (10) And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. [12] Therefore rejoice, [ye] heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. (13) And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man child. [2] And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered. [5] And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne. [15] And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood. (16) And the earth helped the woman, and the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth. (17) And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

Notes:

- Woman = House of Israel
- Sun = Jacob/Israel
- Moon = Jacob's 4 wives
- 12 Stars = 12 tribes of Israel
- Great red dragon = Satan
- Michael = captain of the Lord's host
- The woman's child = Jesus
 - He is the only one who went to heaven and sat at the right hand of the Father.
- The Remnant = servants of God who didn't go to the Wilderness (Place of Safety)
- Serpent = Satan
- 1/3 of the angels fell with Satan and was cast down to the earth.
- Satan will try to stop God's servants from making it to the wilderness, but will not succeed. He will go after those who stayed behind.

Revelation 12:7-10, 12-13, 2, 5, 15-17 And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against



Matthew 25:31-34, 41 When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: (32) *And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:* (33) And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. (34) Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: **41** Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Notes:

- Sheep = The righteous
- Goats – The wicked
- The throne of the his glory = David's throne
- Kingdom prepared from the foundation of the world = New Jerusalem
- It was ready for MAN but MAN was not ready for it. Rather than killing Adam & Eve and staring over, God gave Mankind 7 days to get it together and seek salvation.

2 Peter 2:1, 4-6 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. **4** For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment; (5) And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth *person*, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly; (6) And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned *them* with an overthrow, making *them* an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;

Notes:

- Heresies = dissent, sacrilege, blasphemies
- Chains of darkness = the fallen angels can't show themselves to anyone. They are invisible to us.
- Old world = before the flood

- All of this is an example to all of us and is a WARNING FROM GOD. Beware of him!

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this [is] the whole [duty] of man. (14) For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether [it be] good, or whether [it be] evil.

Notes:

- Duty = responsibility, obligation

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Notes:

- Submit = surrender, yield, capitulate
- As long as you keep God's commandments and walk in his word, the devil will flee from you but he will be back to check on you to see if you are still walking the walk.



Ephesians 6:11, 16-17 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. **16** Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. (17) And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Notes:

- Wiles of the devil = Various temptations, evils, wickedness
- Spiritual wickedness in high places = Satan and his ministers (fallen angels/false prophets/evil doers with high positions in government, media, education, etc. and all people who are wicked)
- Evil day = the day the devil comes at you to tempt you; the great tribulation
- Our FAITH is our SHIELD!
- We all have a choice to make, either
 - the Kingdom of God (New Jerusalem)
 - Or the Lake of Fire.

Luke 4:1-13 And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into

the wilderness, (2) Being forty days tempted of the devil. And in those days he did eat nothing: and when they were ended, he afterward hungered. (3) And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread. (4) And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God. (5) And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. (6) And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. (7) If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine. (8) And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. (9) And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence: (10) For it is written, He shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee: (11) And in *their* hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. (12) And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God. (13) And when the devil had ended all the temptation, he departed from him for a season.

Notes:

- Holy Ghost = The Word of God
- Both God & Satan can bless you, so be aware of where your blessings are coming from.
- Jesus said 'it is said' because he is the one that said it. He is the only God we have known. The Father does not deal with flesh, only spirit.

Ecclesiastes 8:4 Where the word of a king is, there is power: and who may say unto him, What doest thou?

Notes:

- Jesus is a king, and has power and no one can stop him. When he returns he will be both a king and a priest. He is and has always been Melchizedek.



Luke 10:1, 17-20 After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither

he himself would come. ¹⁷ And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name. (18) And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. (19) Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. (20) Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

Notes:

- Jesus told Michael to cast Satan out of heaven.
- Our names are written in heaven in the Book of Life.



Jeremiah 44:1-7, 10-12 The word that came to Jeremiah concerning all the Jews which dwell in the land of Egypt, which dwell at Migdol, and at Tahpanhes, and at Noph, and in the country of Pathros, saying, (2) Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Ye have seen all the evil that I have brought upon Jerusalem, and upon all the cities of Judah; and, behold, this day they are a desolation, and no man dwelleth therein, (3) Because of their wickedness which they have committed to provoke me to anger, in that they went to burn incense, and to serve other gods, whom they knew not, neither they, ye, nor your fathers. (4) Howbeit I sent unto you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending them, saying, Oh, do not this abominable thing that I hate. (5) But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear to turn from their wickedness, to burn no incense unto other gods. (6) Wherefore my fury and mine anger was poured forth, and was kindled in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem; and they are wasted and desolate, as at this day. (7) Therefore now thus saith the LORD, the God of hosts, the God of Israel; Wherefore commit ye this great evil against your souls, to cut off from you man and woman, child and suckling, out of Judah, to leave you none to remain; ¹⁰ They are not humbled even unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in my law, nor in my statutes, that I set before you and before your fathers. (11) Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will set my face against you for evil, and to cut off all Judah. (12) And I will take the remnant of Judah, that have set their faces to go into the land of Egypt to sojourn there, and they shall all be consumed,

and fall in the land of Egypt; they shall even be consumed by the sword and by the famine: they shall die, from the least even unto the greatest, by the sword and by the famine: and they shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach.

Notes:

- The children of Israel are under the curses written in Deuteronomy 28 because of our constant disobedience to our God.
- Execration = to curse, damn

Ezekiel 3:16-19 And it came to pass at the end of *seven days*, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, (17) Son of man, I have made thee a watchman unto the house of Israel: therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me. (18) When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked [man] shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand. (19) Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul.

Notes:

- Watchman = servant of God who warns the people from God
- Iniquity = sin, transgression

Ananias & Sapphira

Acts 5:1-5 But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession, (2) And kept back [part] of the price, his wife also being privy [to it], and brought a certain part, and laid [it] at the apostles' feet. (3) But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back [part] of the price of the land? (4) Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. (5) And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.

Notes:

- Holy Ghost/Spirit = Angel
- Gave up the ghost = Died
- A wife doesn't have to agree with her husband if he's wrong. Don't let your husband take

away your crown of salvation by following him in deceit. Men as well, don't follow your wife in deceit and lose your crown.



Isaiah 66:15-18 For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his anger with fury, and his rebuke with flames of fire. (16) For by fire and by his sword will the LORD plead with all flesh: and the slain of the LORD shall be many. (17) They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one [tree] in the midst, eating swine's flesh, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith the LORD. (18) For I [know] their works and their thoughts: it shall come, that I will gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come, and see my glory.

Notes:

- Plead = kill
- They that sanctify themselves = those who don't follow God's Word but rather the commandments of Men who think they are holier than thou and can eat whatever they want.
- Tree in the midst = Satan

Isaiah 63:7-10 I will mention the lovingkindnesses of the LORD, [and] the praises of the LORD, according to all that the LORD hath bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which he hath bestowed on them according to his mercies, and according to the multitude of his lovingkindnesses. (8) For he said, Surely they [are] my people, children [that] will not lie: so he was their Saviour. (9) In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old. (10) But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, [and] he fought against them.

Notes:

- The Angel of the Lord's presence is Gabriel.
- His holy Spirit (Angel)
- God did everything for Israel but Israel rebelled over and over again.
- Israel rebelled against the Holy Spirit by not destroying the Gibeonites and making a covenant with them.

JESUS

Deuteronomy 32:21, 37, 39 They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation. [37] And he shall say, Where are their gods, their rock in whom they trusted, [39] See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand.

Notes:

- That which is not God = Pagan gods & images
- Not a people = Anyone or any nation
- Our Rock is Jesus. He is the only God that man has known in the earth. All others are pagan. He didn't include the Father because the Father is in the 3rd Heaven and does not interact with flesh.

1 Samuel 2:2, 6-7 There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside thee: neither is there any rock like our God. [6] The LORD killeth, and maketh alive: he bringeth down to the grave, and bringeth up. (7) The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up.

Notes:

- The Lord is in control of everything. Give Him credit and not Satan because He is a jealous God. Give him His Praise.

Jehoshaphat & Ahab

1 Kings 22:1, 4-6, 20-22, 7-9, 13-17, 23 And they continued three years without war between Syria and Israel. [4] And he said unto Jehoshaphat, Wilt thou go with me to battle to Ramothgilead? And Jehoshaphat said to the king of Israel, I *am* as thou *art*, my people as thy people, my horses as thy horses. (5) And Jehoshaphat said unto the king of Israel, Enquire, I pray thee, at the word of the LORD to day. (6) Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, Shall I go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall I forbear? And

they said, Go up; for the Lord shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king. [20] And the LORD said, Who shall persuade Ahab, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one said on this manner, and another said on that manner. (21) And there came forth a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him. (22) And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go forth, and I will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And he said, Thou shalt persuade *him*, and prevail also: go forth, and do so. [7] And Jehoshaphat said, *Is there* not here a prophet of the LORD besides, that we might enquire of him? (8) And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, *There is* yet one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may enquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he doth not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so. (9) Then the king of Israel called an officer, and said, Hasten hither Micaiah the son of Imlah. [13] And the messenger that was gone to call Micaiah spake unto him, saying, Behold now, the words of the prophets *declare* good unto the king with one mouth: let thy word, I pray thee, be like the word of one of them, and speak *that which is* good. (14) And Micaiah said, As the LORD liveth, what the LORD saith unto me, that will I speak. (15) So he came to the king. And the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go against Ramothgilead to battle, or shall we forbear? And he answered him, Go, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king. (16) And the king said unto him, How many times shall I adjure thee that thou tell me nothing but *that which is* true in the name of the LORD? (17) And he said, I saw all Israel scattered upon the hills, as sheep that have not a shepherd: and the LORD said, These have no master: let them return every man to his house in peace. [23] Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee.

Notes:

- The lying Sprit was a fallen angel in the mouth of all of Ahab's 400 prophets.
- Sinning against the Holy Ghost is to know the truth and speak against it.
- You can't escape God. If he calls evil against you, you will get it.

James 2:19 Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.

Notes:

- One God = Jesus (He and the Father are One) – They have the same way of thinking.
